THE SWIM CLUB IS SCHEDULED TO OPEN FOR THE 2020 SEASON ON

MONDAY, JUNE 22nd

**In order to give our members and staff time to become familiar with the social distancing and scheduling procedures,
guests will not permitted during the first week of operation**

The health and safety of the members, their guests, and the staff of the Teaneck Swim Club is our highest priority.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 153 (2020), the Department of Health has developed standards governing the operations of pool facilities, including the securing of staff, staff training, and other overall measures implementing the NJ COVID-19 health and safety standards. Pool facility operators must comply with these standards.

In compliance with these standards, the Teaneck Swim Club has submitted a **COVID-19 Pool Operation Prevention Plan (CPOPP)** to the local Health authority.

In consultation with the Board of Trustees, local government officials, the local health department, and the Pool Director and Manager, the following policies, rules and regulations have been established and will be in effect until further notice:

1. Stay home if you are sick
2. Screenings for fever or signs of COVID-19 illness for patrons will occur at check-in prior to being permitted to enter the facility.
3. Social distancing ("6 FEET RULE") will be in effect on the entire premises, including in the pools

4. Face coverings must be worn while on the premises. Face coverings must cover both the nose and the mouth of the wearer and cannot have an exhalation valve. (Exceptions: 1. Children 2 years old or younger should not wear face coverings. 2. Anyone with a medical condition that precludes the use of a mask is exempt, but there must be evidence.)
5. Face coverings should **NOT** be worn in the water.
6. Footwear is required in all bathrooms/locker rooms/showers. A small outdoor shower has been installed near the Family bathroom.
7. Hands should be washed frequently with soap and water.
8. Hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol should be used if soap and water are not available.
9. Lounge chairs/chairs will not be provided. Members may bring their own chairs for personal use, but must take them home when they leave the club or chain and lock them to a designated area of the fence. Any member may seek a special accommodation from the pool manager. No umbrellas permitted.
10. The concession stand will be closed. Picnic tables and chairs will not be provided. The patio area will be used by lifeguards and staff only.
11. Each day will be divided into sessions to allow for sanitizing the facilities. Pool capacity will determine the number of patrons admitted during each session. Once management determines that capacity is reached, no one will be admitted until another patron leaves. At the end of each session, patrons must leave the facility. (No one is permitted to be on the grounds during the sanitizing process). Session 1 patrons may not return during another session that day until at least 1 hour after the next session starts, and will be admitted only if capacity has not been reached. If capacity is reached, the patrons who have attended more than one session will be asked to leave.

POOL HOURS: MAIN, LAP & KIDDIE POOLS (2 Sessions)

Monday thru Saturday:

Session 1 12 Noon – 3:30 pm (bathrooms will be locked at 3:30)

CLOSED 3:30 – 4:00 pm

Session 2 4:00 pm – 7:30 pm (bathrooms will be locked at 7:30)

Sunday: (3 Sessions):

Session 1 12 Noon – 2:30 pm (bathrooms will be locked at 2:30 pm)

CLOSED 2:30 – 3:00 pm

Session 2 3:00 – 5:30 pm (bathrooms will be locked at 5:30 pm)

CLOSED 5:30 - 6:00 pm

Session 3 6:00 – 7:30 pm (bathrooms will be locked at 7:30 pm)

LAP POOL ONLY - In Addition to the hours stated above:

Monday thru Friday:

Early Bird 7-8 am

Monday thru Sunday:

Morning Swim 10am – 12 Noon

(During these times, the club is open for adult lap swimming only. The lap pool is open; the grounds are closed)

Lap pool restriction: 1 swimmer per lane; the swimmer may be limited to 30 minutes **or less** when others are waiting to swim.

12. Food and beverages may be consumed in the area beyond the refreshment stand patio. However, food deliveries by outside vendors must occur in the parking lot. It is recommended that food and beverages be consumed on the grass area, outside the fence, beyond the refreshment stand patio. You may set up your own tables and chairs in this area. Social distancing must be maintained.
13. The tennis and basketball courts will be open for use.
14. The water fountain has been removed.
15. The slide has been removed.
16. The playground areas are closed.
17. No games/sports equipment will be provided.
18. No toys, noodles, kickboards, tubes, etc. allowed in the kiddie or main pools
19. Goggles may be used, but they should not be shared
20. Members and guests will be required to sign an acknowledgement of these rules and a waiver of liability prior to first entry of the season.
